

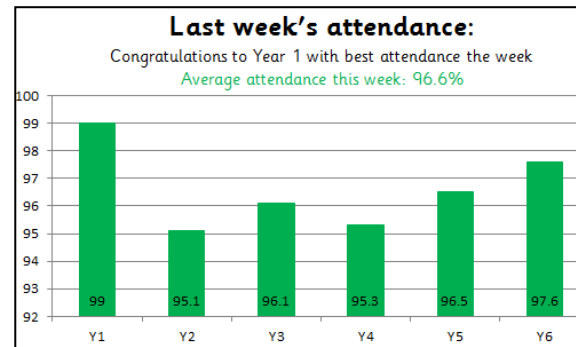

If you believe that you may be able to qualify for Free School Meals, please contact the office. Eligibility means free lunch meals, as well as reduced costs in other areas of school life- Breakfast Club, school trips, etc.
