## Half Term and INSET Day

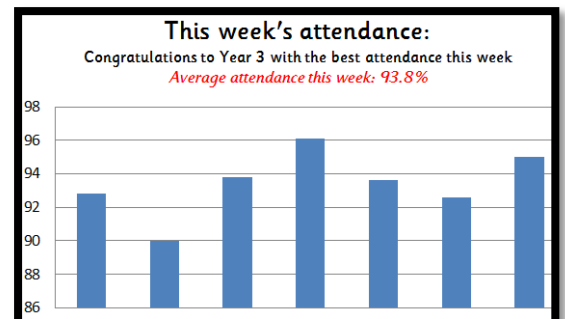
As you know, we break up today for a week. Monday 19<sup>th</sup> February is an INSET day for staff training. Children return on Tuesday. Have a great break.
